Data Source: Census Transportation Planning Package. Trip count is all daily trips (regardless of mode) reported as made between Manhattan and CT. Trips were counted when they began or ended within the boundaries of a town's primary activity area- here defined by employment and population densities within census tracts. Each analyzed "place" consisted of one or more census tracts. Manhattan trips were counted when they began or ended in two conglomerations of census tracts- one centered around midtown's Grand Central Terminal, and one centered on downtown's office area at the southern tip of Manhattan.

The data shows that there is no major source for trips to Manhattan which lacks transit service.
